Ordering Reproductions and Notecards of John James Audubon's *Birds of America* from the University of Pittsburgh Library System

The University of Pittsburgh Library System is pleased to provide print reproductions from its double elephant folio edition of the *Birds of America*.

The reproductions are based on high-resolution digital images of the original work of art scanned by the University's Digital Research Library on an A0 DigiBook SupraScanner. Each plate was digitized at a resolution of 400 ppi true color (24-bit) using a 14000 pixel CCD linear array camera. The digital images can be viewed at audubon.pitt.edu.

We offer four different reprint sizes all produced from the digital source using the giclée process (i.e., ink-jet printing). The Full size is reproduced at 100% of the plate's original size (26 x 38 inches), including a one-inch border extending beyond the actual plate. The plate reproductions are printed on 285 gram smooth fine art paper for digital reproductions. The paper is made of 100% cotton linters and traditional matte finish designed for long-term fade-resistant reproductions. The mould-made fine art paper is free of acid and lignin, thus exhibiting high archival quality. Please note that these reproductions are not scuff-proof and should be treated as fine art.
